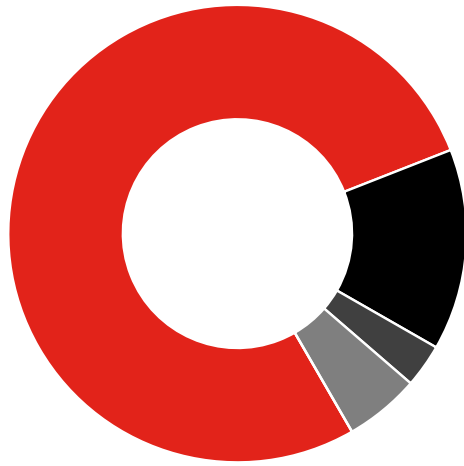

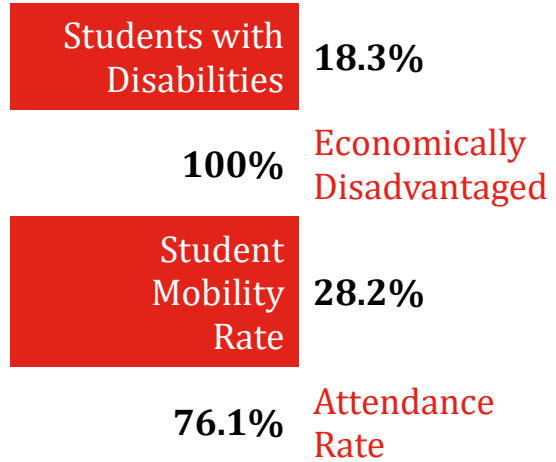
Student Demographics

Progress towards Goals

In **Reading** (iReady), K-8 students demonstrating progress at or above the annual typical growth rate was **88%**. In **Math** (iReady), **93%** of K-8 students are demonstrating progress at or above the annual typical growth rate.

Over the past two years, the **4 Year Graduation rate** increased from **71.9%** to **86.8%**.

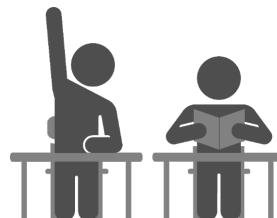
Our Academic Goals

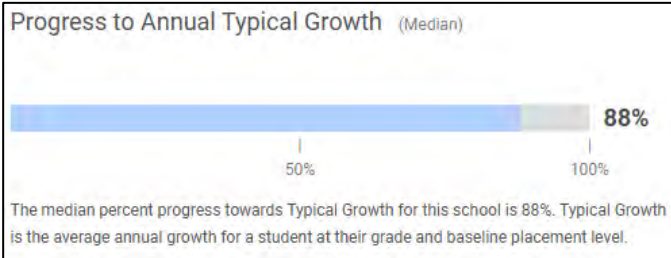

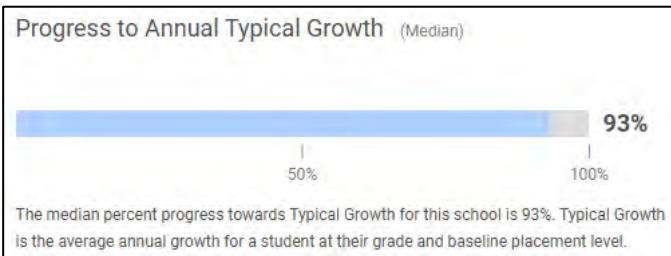

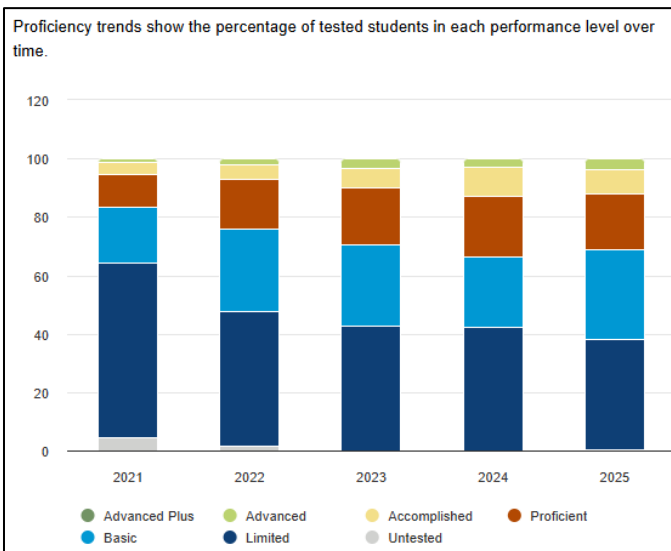
iReady Data Reading



iReady Data Mathematics

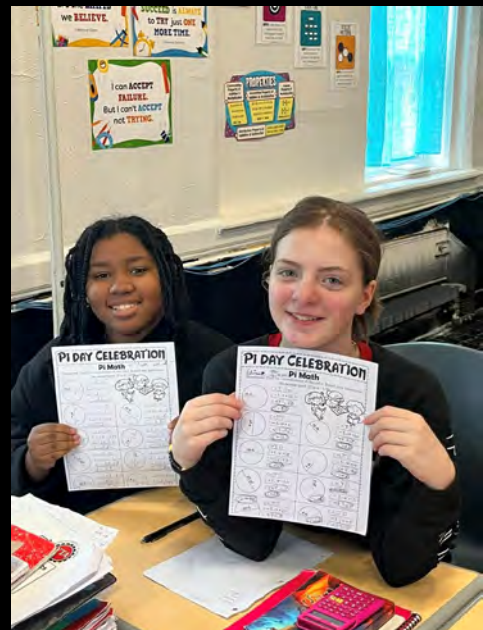


Percent Proficient at Northeast Ohio College Preparatory School
